Whether your book is finished, formatted, and ready for us to print today, or you need a little help with editing, cover/interior design, technical support, or consultation on marketing and distribution, we offer a complete “print-ready” publishing package, as well as an extensive menu of à la carte services.

You always own all the rights to your work. Once we publish your book, **we will make it available for sale** for at least three months at the **Northshire Bookstore’s** brick-and-mortar store, and we’ll also list it for sale via the Northshire Bookstore’s website at www.northshire.com and through www.amazon.com for the duration of your Shires Press Author Contract (one-year extendable term). **You set your own retail price**, and **you keep 100%** of the difference between what you pay us to print your book and whatever retail price you set.

You provide us with print-ready .pdf (“portable document format”) computer files of your book’s interior pages and cover, formatted just the way you want them to look, and we load your files and print a high-quality paperback edition of your book on nice recycled paper (choose white or off-white) with black-and-white interior pages and a full-color glossy cover, in any size you want from 5" x 7" to 8" x 10.5". (For specific instructions on how to submit your book, please ask for a copy of our “Submission Guidelines.”)

With the Print-Ready Publishing Package, you give us your book once it’s “final”—that is, you’ve done (or hired someone to help you do) all the writing, editing, and proofreading; design and layout of the cover and interior pages; ISBN, I.C, and barcode if you want them; computer formatting and conversion to .pdf—and everything is good to go and ready to publish. Depending on the paper you choose (fancier papers and cover stocks are available at an additional charge), we can print books with a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 550 pages.

- We suggest printing 1 “proof” copy of your book for you and your eagle-eyed friends to review one last time before we print more copies
- Each additional copy of your book, without changes, will be charged at per page costs listed above
- Author Alterations (“AAs”; corrections or other changes you ask us to make to your proof copy, then we prepare a new .pdf file)

- Make your own changes and submit a new .pdf file

Editing Services

(Per-word charges are calculated based on a word count of the entire raw manuscript you submit, before editing.)

- Manuscript Evaluation - a professional editor reviews your manuscript and provides a written report on what editorial services (if any) are recommended and why.

ISBN/Barcode

An ISBN (International Standard Book Number) is a 13-digit identification number that allows a specific edition of a book—for example, paperback, hardcover, audiobook, ebook—to be tracked anywhere in the global marketplace. If you want the option of selling your book through the Northshire Bookstore or to other retailers, distributors, or libraries, you’ll need an ISBN and barcode. We can assign your book an ISBN and barcode right now that lists Shires Press as the publisher (or you can go to www.isbn.org for instructions on how to purchase your own ISBN, listing you as the publisher, for about \$125 for 1 ISBN + \$25 for 1 barcode; this takes about 2 weeks when you do it yourself). We’ll print your ISBN on your book’s copyright page and place an ISBN barcode on the back cover of your book. In addition, we will register your book with Books in Print, an online database that is one of the main resources bookstores and libraries around the world rely on to order books.

Copyright

Registering a copyright on a work documents who the originator/creator is and protects the work against misappropriation or other unauthorized use. We can complete your copyright registration application for you and file it with the U.S. Copyright Office at the Library of Congress (or you can register your own copyright for about \$50 via www.copyright.gov). Copyright becomes effective the day the Library of Congress receives a copy of your published book; it may take 4–5 months for the LC to send your official certification of copyright to you through the mail. We will print your copyright information on your book's copyright page.

- Basic Copyright - for a literary work that is written by only one author who is the only copyright owner

Library of Congress (LC) Control Number

A Library of Congress Preassigned Card/Control Number (PCN) links your book to any record that the Library of Congress or other libraries, bibliographic utilities, or book vendors may create. If you want your book to be eligible for inclusion in libraries, you will probably want a PCN. We can take care of your PCN application; it takes about 1–2 weeks for the Library of Congress to send us your individual PCN (or you can go to the Library of Congress website at <http://pcn.loc.gov/> for instructions on how to get your own PCN). Once the Library of Congress assigns your PCN, we'll print it on your book's copyright page.
